During the month of June, there were sales totaling \$8343.36! This is slightly under last year's sales for the month of June.

Total sales for the year total \$23,688.61!!! That's terrific! This compares to last year's sales to date figures of \$19,212.65. Good job!

At a recent planning meeting of the State Chapter, it was decided that all proceeds of the gift shop will be funneled back into the preserve in two ways: (1) to buy bison in the fall to continue to expand the genetic diversity of our herd, and (2) support of the Docent program through supplies, and recognition of our volunteers.

Visitation

During the month of June, 1877 visitors came to the Prairie. These numbers were down about 9.8% from June 1996, but up from the previous two years. Total visitation year-to-date is 6345, about .2% more than cumulative at this time last year, and higher than all previous years.

720 of our visitors came from 43 other states. Visitors from all fifty states have now visited the Preserve this year.

52 visitors came from 12 other countries.

Wednesdays through Sundays continue to be our biggest visitation days.

New Ornament For Sale in Gift Shop -

A new pewter ornament is now for sale in the gift shop. It is part of a series that The Nature Conservancy hopes to develop for all of the Last Great Places. The first two locations picked from the original list of Great Places were the Tallgrass Prairie and the Florida Keyes.

The ornaments were crafted in the USA by Dave Cusenza. They are handmade and the molds are individually poured. The ornaments are then antiqued and hand-finished and finally, numbered. The artist has crafted ornaments for the national parks and his most recent work, the State of Washington Capital ornament, was a gift to the Clinton White House holiday tree from the governor of Washington.

TRAIL GUIDES UPDATE

SPEAKERS BUREAU Training

Most of you are aware that we have a special group of volunteers who have been trained to give slide presentations and programs on both the Tallgrass Prairie Preserve and the statewide efforts of The Nature Conservancy. Since the program originated in January 1996, we have held three trainings. It is time for a fourth training, if enough people are interested.

Please call the Tulsa office and let Mary know that you would like to attend training. Tentatively, the date for this training will be August 26 or 28 at the Tulsa office. If you have already been trained, but need a refresher, you are welcome to attend as well.

A complete script, full of information about the Conservancy and the slides, is available at the training, as well as other information to help you answer questions from the audience. The training will consist of a review of the slides and the script information. You will be asked to fill out a sheet telling us when you are available to serve as a speaker, and what age groups you would prefer to address. Speakers boxes are available in Tulsa, Pawhuska, and Bartlesville, with sets of slides and Conservancy information. When we have a request from your community, you may be called to see if you can serve as the speaker.

We recently advertised the Speakers Bureau through a letter sent out to area clubs, and calls have been coming in.

Volunteer speakers do not have to be docents, so recruit your friends and RSVP for the training!


Scheduling
